Rosh Hashana celebrates the Jewish New Year of 5779, beginning Sun. and Mon., Sept 9 and 10.

The 10 days of awe will culminate on the holiest holy day, Yom Kippur, the day of atonement, on Tues. and Wed., Sept 18 and 19.
