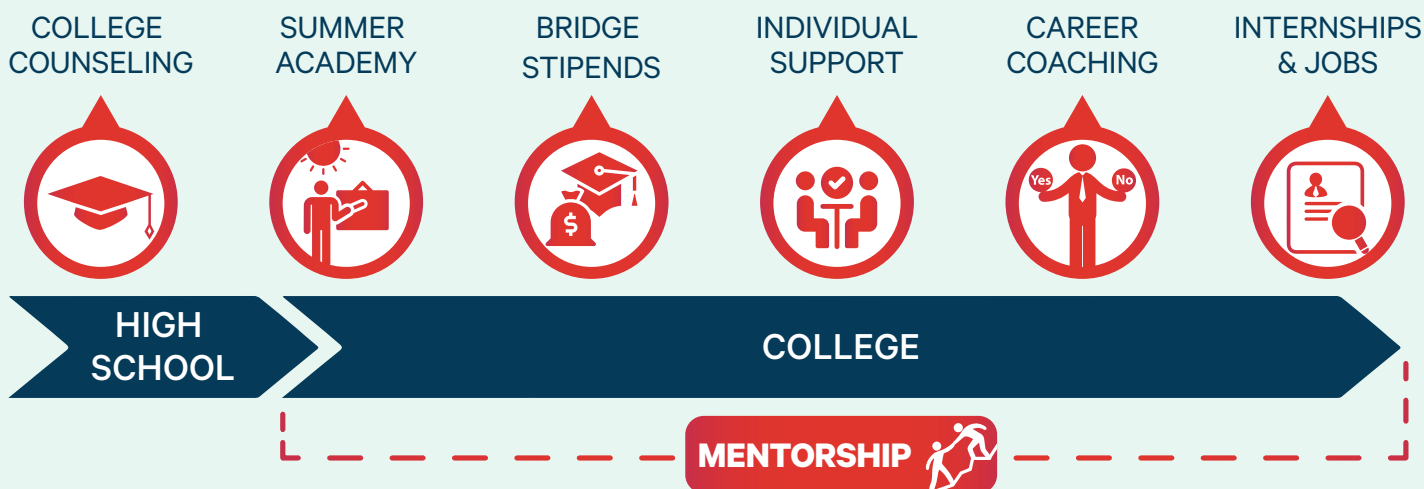


The mission of SCS Noonan Scholars is to help high-achieving low-income underrepresented students get into and graduate from top colleges equipped to achieve their full career potential.

Thrive Mentorship

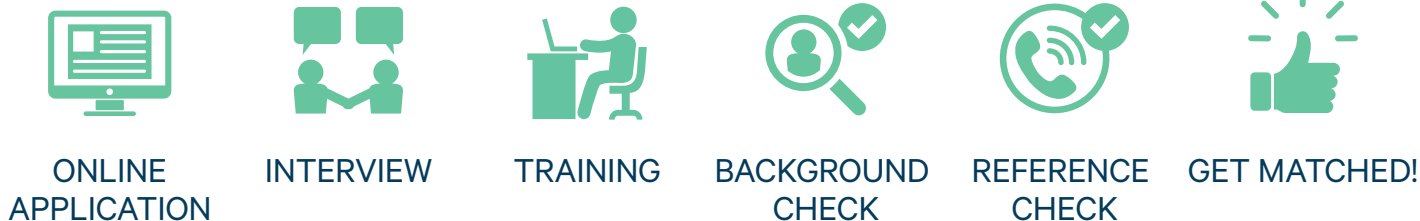
Are you excited about connecting with a student and supporting them in navigating the college experience? In **Thrive Mentorship**, mentors support Scholars in building strong foundations. **Pairs commit to communicating monthly for a year**, building a connection and tackling topics like time management, dealing with stress, finding a campus community, and the first-gen student experience.

Launch Mentorship

Do you enjoy exposing people to professional opportunities and helping them clarify their career interests? Through **Launch Mentorship**, mentors guide Scholars in exploring future possibilities. **Mentoring cycles are time-bound and goal-oriented**, typically lasting 6 to 12 weeks and ranging in focus from an industry deep-dive to navigating your first intern experience and more.

Mentoring pairs from any track who wish to continue past their original commitment are welcome to do so, and all relationships receive ongoing support from SCS Noonan staff.
