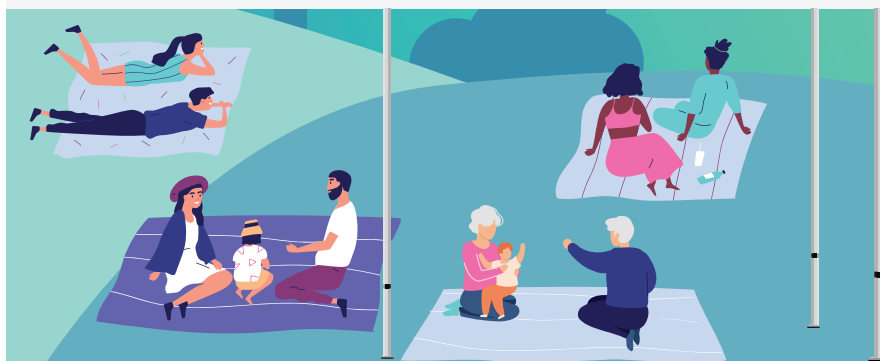
2:15pm on Rosh Hashanah Day
