Tallit to Torah and kiss, then chant the blessing

1. בְּרוּךְ יְיָ אֱתָהּ יְיָ הַמְּבָרֵךְ.

Congregation responds with the second line, and then you repeat the same line

2. בְּרוּךְ יְיָ הַמְּבָרֵךְ לְעוֹלָם וָעֶד.

3. בְּרוּךְ יְיָ אֱתָהּ יְיָ

4. אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם

5. אֲשֶׁר בָּחַר-בְּנוּ מִכָּל-הָעַמִּים,

6. וְנָתַן-לָנוּ אֶת תּוֹרָתוֹ.

7. בְּרוּךְ יְיָ אֱתָהּ יְיָ, נוֹתֵן הַתּוֹרָה.

After the Torah Blessing

Tallit to Torah and kiss, then chant the blessing

1. בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי ,
2. אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם ,
3. אֲשֶׁר נָתַן-לָנוּ תּוֹרַת אֱמֶת ,
4. וְהֵי עוֹלָם נִטַּע בְּתוֹכָנוּ .
5. בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה יי , נוֹתֵן הַתּוֹרָה .

Praised be our Eternal God, Guide of the universe,
 who has given us a Torah of truth, implanting within us eternal life.
 We praise You, Eternal One, Giver of the Torah.
